Introduction:

The geography curriculum is a spiral curriculum in which the boys will revisit topics and build on their knowledge and understanding of various geographical concepts.

Key Objectives:

- To improve global location knowledge of various European countries
- To improve global location knowledge of various non-European countries
- To understand coastal processes
- To identify features of coastal erosion and deposition
- To understand which coastal defence systems are used in the UK
- To understand how earthquakes and volcanoes form
- To complete case studies on two volcanoes and two earthquakes
