Introduction

This term begins with a review of the scholar's holiday reading and a review of their holiday work. A high degree of accuracy and the use of sophisticated vocabulary is expected, together with clarity of expression. Past papers from appropriate schools are undertaken with answers being analysed and discussed. All pupils are expected to read out their answers and partake in group discussion.

The library lesson might involve individual reading, completion of unfinished scholarship questions or quiet discussion with the teacher about their work and progress.
