Introduction:

The geography curriculum is a spiral curriculum in which the boys will revisit topics and build on their knowledge and understanding of various geographical topics.

Key Objectives:

- Understand the various sources of energy and power which we use, including fossil fuels and green energy.
- Understand the environmental impacts of the various sources of energy and power.
- Understand how energy can be produced and used sustainably
- Know the location of the world's rainforests
- Understand rainforest ecosystems
- Understand the benefits of rainforests
- Understand reasons for deforestation
- Understand the consequences, both locally and globally, of deforestation
- Know the location of the world's major river systems
- Know the location of the world's oceans and major seas
- Know what is meant by the terms latitude and longitude, and identify the main lines of latitude and longitude.
