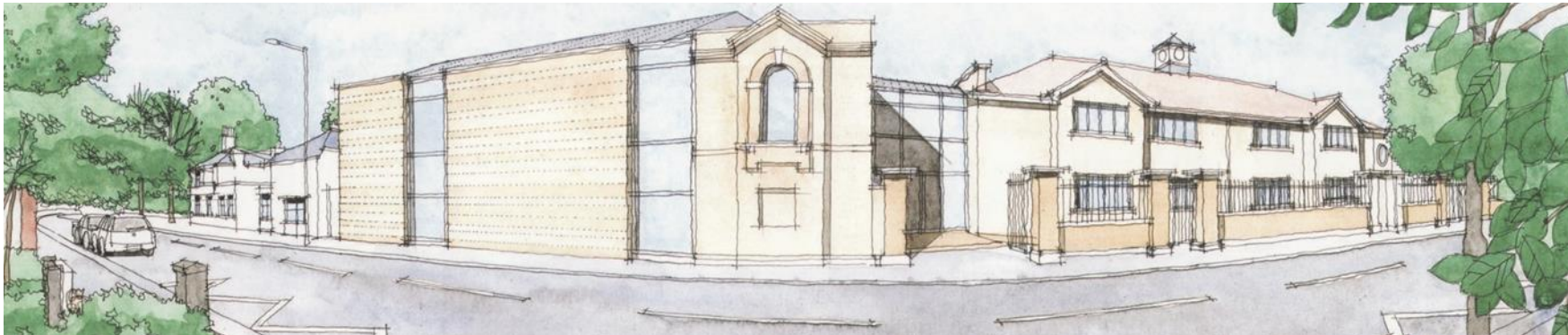


School reopening September 2020

Main points

- Three 'bubbles': Reception to Year 2; Years 3 and 4; Years 5 and 6.
- Boys remain in their bubbles as far as possible: games, break and lunch times, assemblies.
- Staggered start and finish times.
- Within bubbles boys are taught in their classes and follow a normal curriculum.
- Maintain social distancing as far as is practical and reasonable.
- Boys will wear school uniform.
- Siblings.

Staggered collection

Year 3 (Mon, Wed, Fri) 3.40 to 3.50 p.m.

Year 3 (Tue and Thu) 4.00 to 4.10 p.m.

Year 4 4.00 to 4.10 p.m.

Curriculum

- All the normal subjects taught by subject specialists where appropriate.
- Lessons taught in the classroom with teachers moving rooms.
- One way system in the Ellis building.
- Science practical lessons for Year 4 in the large lab.
- Art in the art room and design technology in the DT workshop.
- IT in classrooms.
- Class library for Reception to Year 4.
- Music and drama in the theatre.
- PE in the sports hall or playground.
- Swimming in the pool.
- Games for Years 3 to 6 at Sunbury Cricket Club (separate afternoons for the two bubbles).
- Boys to come to school in games kit on those days.
- Assemblies in the theatre in bubbles.

- Boys will have games on the first day of term.
- Year 3 and 4 boys will wear their games kit to school on Tuesday and Thursday.
- Boys to bring in their PE kit on the first two days of term.

Other events

- Concerts and performances will be filmed and placed on Teams.
- Parents evenings will be on Zoom.
- Day trips will go ahead but residential trips are on hold.
- Extra-curricular clubs will operate in bubbles.
- Minibus.
- One assembly each week for each bubble.
- No homework diary
- Reading record for all year groups.

Control measures

- Hand hygiene.
- Catch it, kill it, bin it.
- Increased cleaning at the end of the day.
- Limit the interaction between boys in different bubbles.
- Avoid sharing equipment.
- Equipment cleaned between use where this is not possible.
- Test and Trace programme.

Other measures

- Boys, parents and staff to follow the relevant quarantine regulations if they have been out of the country.
- Boys, parents or staff must not come onto the school site if they have symptoms of COVID-19.
- High temperature, new continuous cough, loss or change in the sense of smell/taste.
- Stay at home: guidance for households with possible or confirmed coronavirus (COVID-19) infection
- Temperature taken at the start of the day.
- No PPE except for staff who are looking after a boy with suspected COVID-19 infection.
- All boys and staff are expected to attend.
- Staff or parents who have concerns should discuss these with the Headmaster.
- Boys not attending will have to follow the timetable and access lessons via Teams.
- These lessons will not be recorded.
- If the school has to close then we will provide remote learning.
