Admissions Process

All prospective parents are invited to have an individual tour of the school with the Headmaster prior to registering.

Entry at 4+ (Reception)

Admission into Reception at the age of 4 is non-selective. In Reception and Year 1 we can accommodate up to two classes of 18 pupils. These boys then transfer automatically through the school until they leave at the age of 11 at the end of Year 6. Once we reach the maximum number of registrations for entry we will operate a waiting list so we advise that if you would like your son to come to The Mall School, you register him as early as possible to avoid disappointment.

Once registered, you will be added to our mailing list to keep you up-to-date with school events and news. You will also be invited to regular family events to give boys and parents the opportunity to get to know staff and each other in advance of starting school.

Eighteen months prior to your son's start date we will write to you confirming our offer of a place and requesting a deposit to secure his place. If you do not accept your son's place by the specified date we may offer it to families on a waiting list.

Timeline for entry into Reception:

- Registration period open until the end of February eighteen months prior to entry. So for example, for entry into Reception in September 2023 the registration period will end on 28 February 2022. When we receive your registration we will write to you confirming receipt and advising whether you have a reserved place or if you are on a waiting list.
- On 1 March 2022 we write to all families with a reserved place for September 2023 with a formal offer and ask them to accept by payment of a deposit by 31 August 2022 (ie one year prior to entry). After this date we may offer places to families on the waiting list.
- In the summer term prior to starting school, boys and parents visit the school in small groups to meet the Headmaster and key staff.
- Each June there is an evening reception for new Reception parents to meet their son's class teacher, other key staff and each other. In the following days, boys come to school for the morning to meet their new classmates and teacher.

Timeline for entry into Reception 2022:

• Families who register within 12 months of their son starting in Reception 2022 will be advised if places are still available, and if so will be asked to accept by payment of a deposit within 2 weeks.

Entry into other year groups and immediate in-year admissions

Places in all other year groups are sometimes available and subject to a successful assessment, which will take place during the

academic year prior to entry in September. If you are looking for an immediate (in-year) place for your son in any year group, including Reception, this is also subject to availability and following a successful assessment. The school occasionally awards bursaries for entry at 7+/8+, for more information please contact the School's Bursar. All bursary applications are made in the strictest confidence.
