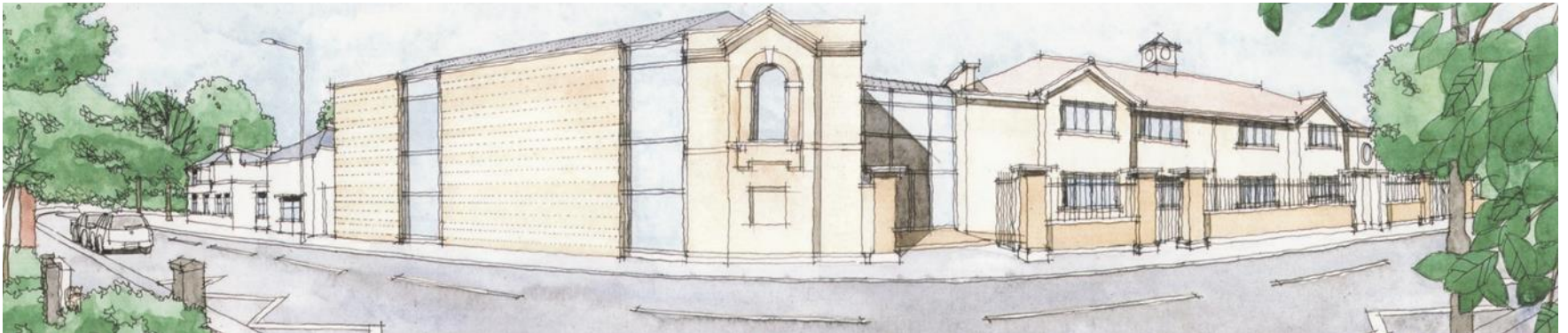


## Awards to senior school

Over the last three years boys were awarded 26 academic scholarships to Hampton, King's College School, Kingston Grammar, Radnor House, St James and St George's.

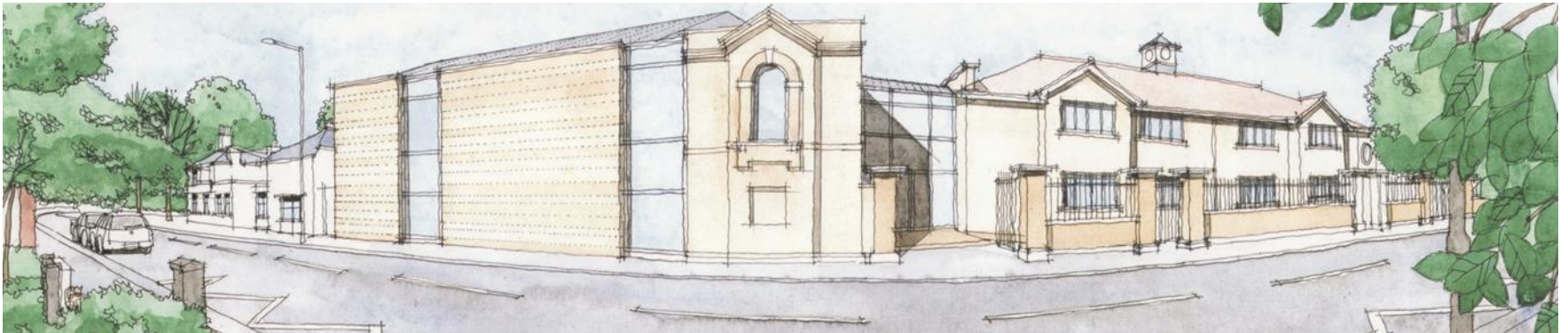
Boys were awarded 18 non-academic scholarships to Epsom College, Halliford, Hampton, Licensed Victuallers' School, Radnor House, St George's and St James'. Awards included chess, music and sport.

All boys met the entrance requirements for at least one school. Over 70% of boys received two or more offers.



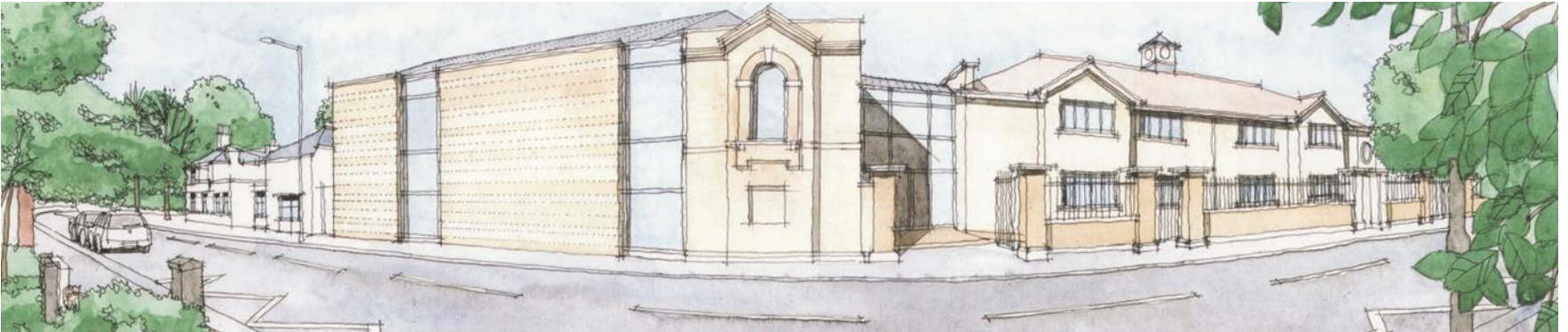
## Feedback from past pupils and parents

- How many senior schools?

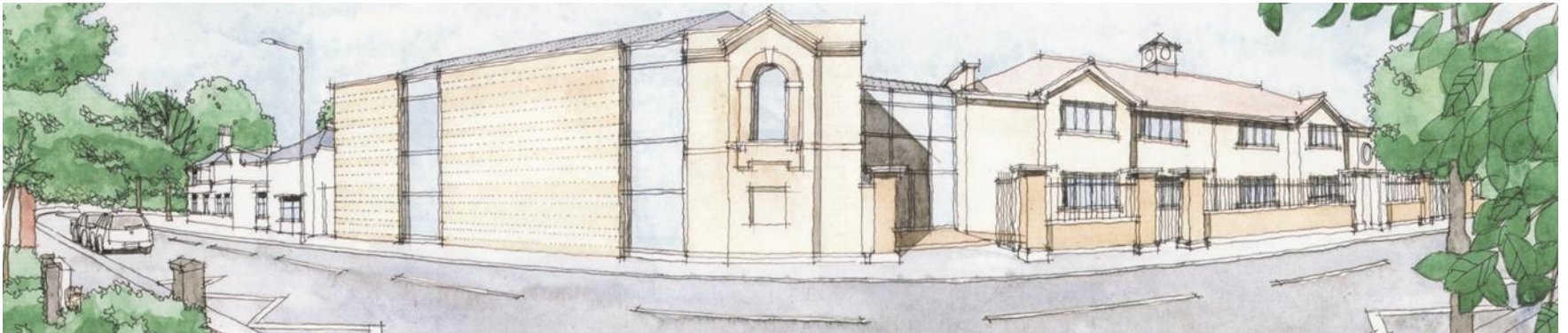

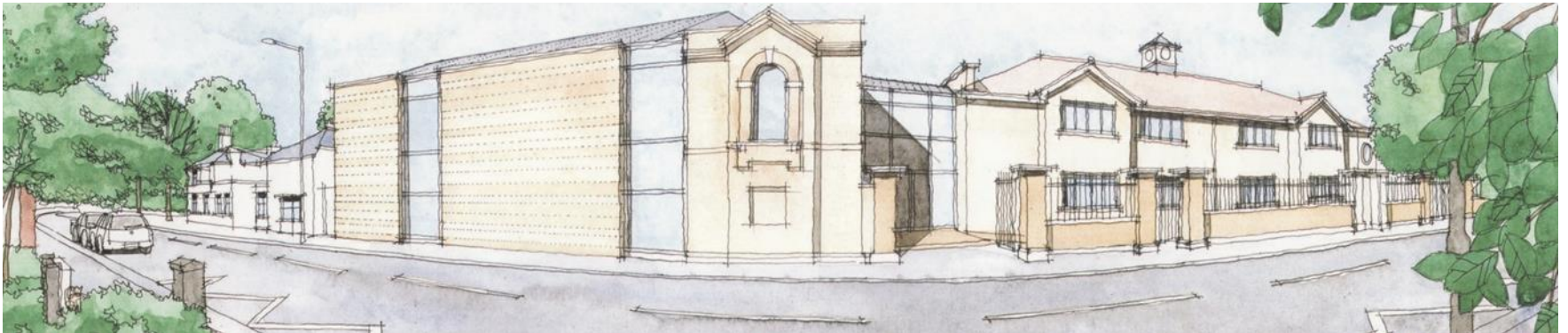
## What you can do?
